

Parliamentary Rules for Correct Signing of Petitions.

Please follow these guidelines as closely as possible, otherwise the Clerks may find a reason to discard the Petition. If one line is incorrect on a page, the entire sheet will be discarded, which is an obvious waste of signatures.

1. Sign on the given lines only and NEVER on the back.
2. Write FULL name and address with no abbreviations, not just a suburb.
3. Do not use dittos - if your address is the same as the person above, you must write it out again in full.
4. Do not scribble anywhere on the form – if your pen won't work, scribble on another sheet first.
5. There is no minimum age for signing a petition.
6. Fill every form if possible.
7. Any forms with ditto marks, incomplete details, scribble marks or signatures on the back will be thrown away. One bad signature will lose the whole form.
8. DO NOT SIGN TWICE. If the same person is found to have signed more than twice, the **WHOLE PETITION** becomes illegal and will be discarded.
